Breaking news – Our Juniors are Awesome!





Replace 4.11 above in Section 4 Classes of Membership with

Replace 4.1.1 Full Member (Playing & Family) with 4.1.1 Full Member

Replace 4.6 below

4.6. The class of membership of Family membership shall consist of two adults and one or more children under the age of 16. The two adults shall for the purposes of these Rules be deemed to be Full Members.
